## **Overall Objective**

Enhance maritime security and safety in the **Indo-Pacific** through cross-sectoral, inter-agency and cross-regional cooperation

### **Specific Objectives and Outputs**

- SO1: Enhance information exchange and analysis
- **SO2:** Strengthen **interagency / regional cooperation** in maritime surveillance, policing, investigation and judiciary (Asia ONLY)
- SO3: Improve compliance and adherence to relevant existing international legal instruments and regional arrangements (Asia ONLY)

  - EU / EEA Member States surveillance systems interoperable






- Single Information Sharing Environment

# IORIS - KEY STRENGTHS 1/2



#### Neutral

- Oversight/access to data governed by data owner
- Access can be open to all, or limited to specific operations/incidents
- Interoperability with data sources and potential for more.
  - AIS and VMS
- Secure Encrypted end-to-end
  - 2 factor authentication user login
  - Integrated file encryption
  - Permanent event logs
  - Auditing functions





# IORIS - KEY STRENGTHS 2/2



- Duplicate training platform
  - Identifiable by Red Banner



- Multi-lingual
  - English / French / Portuguese / Arabic / Somali plus ...
- Aircraft and Vessels
  - Low bandwidth version




