

Leonid Polyakov, Advisor to Director of National Institute For Strategic Studies, Ukraine

Has worked as Deputy Minister of Defense in March 2014-May 2014, First Deputy Minister of Defense in 2005-2008, and as Director at the Razumkov Center, Military (Security/Defense) Programs in 2000-2005. Since 2009 he chairs the Advisory Board at Center for Army, Conversion and Disarmament Studies. His 20 years of military service include command postings in the Soviet Army, including a combat tour in Afghanistan, and service in the General Staff of Ukrainian Armed Forces. His academic record includes Harvard University Fellowship, 2008 - 2009; Senior Executive Course, George C. Marshall Center, 2001; US Army War College, 1995; Frunze Military Academy, Moscow, 1993; Kyiv Combined-Arms Command Military School, 1983; Kyiv Radio-Electronics Technical College, 1979. He published over 100 articles and monographs on issues related to national security governance and defense institution building.
