Detect IUU fishing where it occurs



Improve traceability of imported products



Stop IUU fish and fish products from reaching markets



Impose consequences for IUU fishing



Collaborate to address associated labor abuses



U.S. Government Mandates

 President Biden signed a National Security Memorandum to address IUU fishing and related harmful fishing practices

 U.S. Interagency Working Group on IUU Fishing, released its National Five-Year Strategy for Combating IUU Fishing (2022-2026)

Climate Change & Fisheries in the Pacific




Figure 3. Projected mean distributions of skipjack and yellowfin tuna biomass across the tropical Pacific Ocean under a high-emissions scenario (IPCC RCP8.5) in 2050, relative to 2005 (Senina et al., 2018).
