Frank Jüris focuses in his research on China's domestic and foreign policy, EU-China and Sino-Russian relations. Jüris studied in Estonia and Taiwan and has lectured at the universities of Tartu and Tallinn. In recent publications for EFPI and *Sinopsis*, he has exposed the involvement of party-state agencies in Arctic infrastructure projects, Estonian politics and critical infrastructure in the European Union. In a new analysis for the European Parliament, he highlights security risks beyond direct ownership related to PRC involvement in the EU critical infrastructure from undersea cable systems to rare earths processing plant.
