## American Definitions

- **Maritime Domain Awareness (MDA)** is the effective understanding of anything associated with the maritime domain that could impact the security, safety, economy, or environment of the United States
  - The purpose of MDA is to facilitate timely, accurate, and informed decision-making.
- The **Maritime Domain** is all areas and things of, on, under, relating to, adjacent to, or bordering on a sea, ocean, or other navigable waterway, including all maritime-related activities, infrastructure, people, cargo, vessels, and other conveyances
- Identified as a vital part of maritime security, for which there is no definition...
- If your definition is “everything” then is it meaningful?

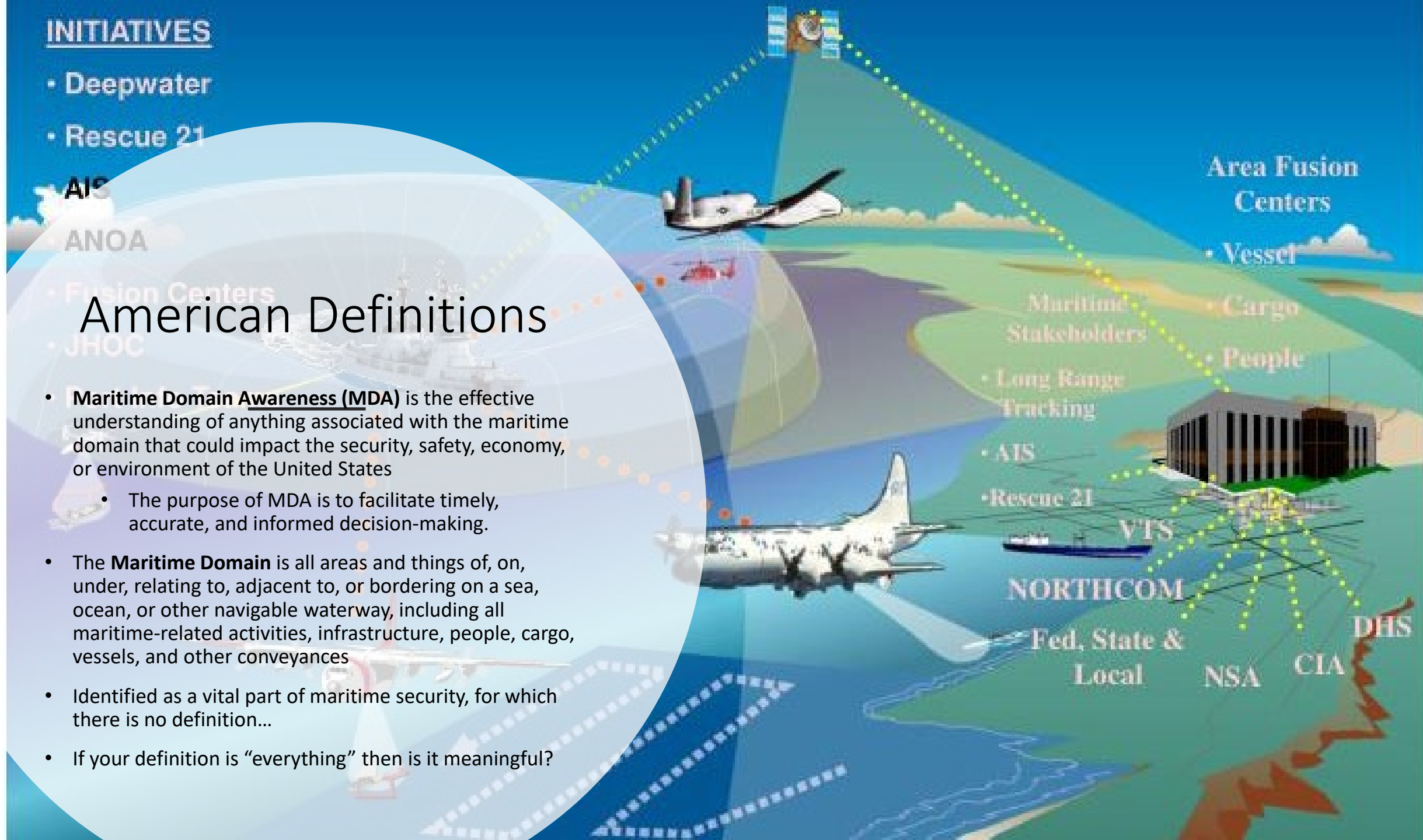

# US Views on MDA

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- Early efforts shaped by 9/11
- National Strategy for Maritime Security
  - Components include National Plan to Achieve Domain Awareness (2005), Global Maritime Intelligence Integration Plan
    - Created Senior Steering Group for MDA, co-chairs Defense and Homeland Security
  - Superseded by National Maritime Domain Awareness Plan (2013) which consolidated both into one strategy



# Global MDA Goals

- Prevent terrorist attacks and criminal, harmful, or hostile acts across the maritime domain by state and non-state actors
- Protect population centers and critical infrastructure
- Minimize damage to, and expedite recovery of, the maritime transportation system and related infrastructure in the wake of man-made or natural disasters
- Maintain unimpeded access to global resources and markets
- Safeguard the oceans and their resources.

# Multilateral Action

- National Maritime Intelligence-Integration Office (NMIO)
  - Global Maritime Community of Interest (GMCOI)
- US-Canada
  - Deep operational coordination, shiprider agreements, information sharing
- Bahrain
  - International Maritime Security Construct (IMSC)
- Indo-Pacific
  - Representative at IFC-IOR in Delhi
  - Less formal representation at Singapore's Changi IFC

## MISSION

The IFC is to collect and disseminate relevant White Shipping and maritime information in its Area of Interest, in order to produce accurate, reliable, impartial and objective IMSEC information for related DPCEUs and the shipping community, to achieve Safe and Secure Seas for All.
